Resolves departmental engineering/surveying and project problems in the absence of the County Engineer. Performs records research, engineering design and cost analysis for road, bridge, culvert, and guardrail projects. Submits proposed plan to County Engineer for approval. Inspects new bridges for compliance with approved construction plans and specifications. Inspects and/or assists in the inspection of existing bridges as necessary. Conducts field inspections of proposed subdivisions. Prepares permits for oil and gas drillers, coal, gas, telephone and other utility companies. Performs engineering calculations and cost analysis for resurfacing projects, bridge projects, paint striping, dust control, and other departmental projects. Prose3sses road vacation and/or dedicates and makes appropriate changes onto County Highway Maps. Conducts road views as required and report findings to County Board of Commissioners and County Engineer. Prepares bid for various contracting out road and bridge projects. Attends bid awards representing County Engineer at County Board of Commissioner meeting. Assists and consults with County Engineer on awarding of Bids. Assists in the maintenance and updates of inventory record of all County road signs and culverts consisting of date and location of installation. Conducts traffic counts and speed zone studies on County Highways as required. Provides various engineering and technical information to township officials, other public officials and general public.
