Who is Eligible to Participate?

Section 5513.01(B) of Ohio Revised Code: Counties, Townships, Municipalities, Conservancy districts, Township Park Districts, Port authorities, Regional Transit authorities, Regional Water and Sewer districts, County Transit Boards, or State Universities and Colleges



ODOT's Authority to Purchase

Ohio Revised Code

ODOT receives a special Release and Permit each biennium from State Procurement (DAS) to issue contracts for specific items independently from their Agency.

Written Request Requirements

S A Signed Ordinance or Resolution:

We need a certified copy of the ordinance or resolution of the Legislative Authority, Board of Trustees or Governing Board of the Political Subdivision requesting authority to participate in such contracts and agreeing that it will be bound by the contract terms and conditions.

Resolution/Ordinance is valid for (2) years. Salt requires a specific resolution that must be completed every year <u>before</u> the salt contract goes out for bid.



Written Request Requirements (cont.)

Along with your resolution/ordinance, we must have a written request from an authorized agent stating the entity wants to use an ODOT Co-op contract. You must specify the vendor as well as the items you are wishing to purchase.

What are Political Subdivisions Responsible for?

ODOT will send an approval letter to the requesting entity as well as the awarded vendor on the contract.



Once the written authorization to purchase has been given by ODOT, orders will be placed directly with the vendor by the political subdivision. ODOT will not have any involvement after approval has been given unless contractual issues arise.
